CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



OUR UNIVERSITY RESULTS

1

Fourth semester (II Year) B.Sc Nursing students received 97% pass rates in October 2024 university exams as a result of the teachers' diligent coaching and direction. Thirty two Students received distinction grades in their major subjects.

In October 2024, first-year M.Sc. (N) students passed all university exams, thanks to the lecturers' careful guidance and coaching. In their major subjects, eight students received distinction grades.

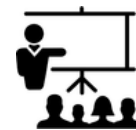

CAMPUS PLACEMENT



ROYAL CARE HOSTEL

Royal Care Hospital held a campus recruiting for final-year students to apply for the Staff Nurse post on December 17. The student interview was conducted by a team of five people. A total of 94 students participated in the group discussion. Our students achieved their goals, and the Royal Care team had a very great overall experience and feedback.



KMCH HOSPITALS

ALTERNATIVE MEDICINE DAY

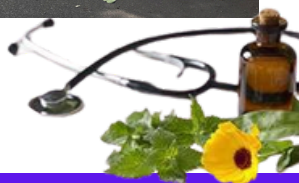

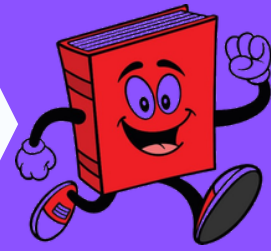

Professional Development Club organized the journal presentation on every second and Fourth Saturday from October 2024 to December 2024.

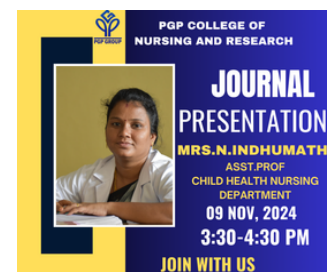
Every presentation generated lively debates and gave attendees insightful information, making it both thought-provoking and educational.

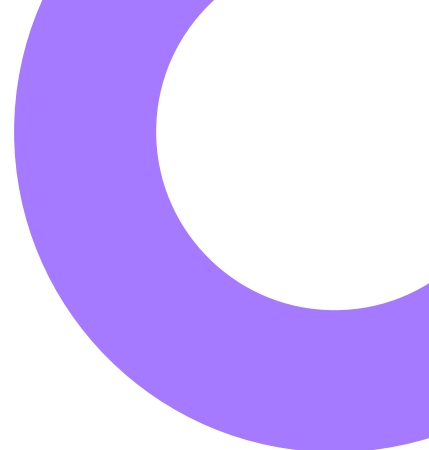
